



GRADUATION 2011 FALCON STADIUM ENTRANCE POLICIES

- All persons and personal belongings entering the stadium are subject to search. Guests may be asked to step through magnetometers and may have bags, purses and other hand-carried items manually searched.
- The following items are **NOT** permitted in Falcon Stadium:
 - Alcoholic beverages
 - Food or drink
 - Factory-sealed transparent soft plastic water bottles, 24 oz. or less are permitted
 - Exceptions will be made for medical conditions and infants
 - Glass containers or cans
 - Empty transparent soft plastic bottles 24 oz. or less are permitted
 - Artificial noisemakers of any kind, including megaphones
 - Bags larger than 8" x 11". Hard-sided containers
 - Diaper bags are permitted if infant is present
 - Banners or large signs (no signs larger than 18" x 24")
 - Laser pointers
 - Pets (other than working service dogs)
 - Sticks, poles (small umbrellas may be brought into the stadium)
 - Weapons, firearms, fireworks
 - Baby seats, large strollers
 - Collapsible strollers are permitted (Note: baby must have ticket for a seat)
 - Items that cannot be readily inspected
 - Backpacks to include bota bags, wine-skins, and camelbacks
 - Infant carrier packs permitted if infant is present
 - Items deemed unsafe by security personnel
 - Flash photography is not permitted; cameras and binoculars are permitted but you may be asked to remove the lenses for inspection at the gates
 - Smoking is not permitted within Falcon Stadium
 - Storage of prohibited or any other items is not offered (we recommend you return any unauthorized items to your vehicle before entering the stadium)
- Seatbacks 18" or less are permitted as long as they don't require a search due to excessive pockets and compartments.
- Military members and cadets must have their military ID card.
